

PAYMENT PLANS

REC CAMP INFO:

DROP OFF AT 8:00AM AT COLEBROOK SCHOOL PLAYGROUND

- PICK UP AT 4:00PM AT COLEBROOK SCHOOL PLAYGROUND
- THE PROGRAM WILL RUN MONDAY-THURSDAY EACH WEEK.
- SIBLINGS WILL BE SPLIT WHEN POSSIBLE
- EACH THURSDAY ALL CAMPERS WILL GO ON A FIELD TRIP OR SPECIAL ADVENTURE (CAMP DISMISSAL ON FIELD TRIP DAYS MAY VARY)
- FIELD TRIP SHIRTS MUST BE WORN FOR EACH FIELD TRIP; A SHIRT OF SIMILAR COLOR IS NOT AN OPTION.
- PARTICIPANTS MUST BRING LUNCH, WATER BOTTLE, SUNSCREEN DAILY. BRING TOWEL, CHANGE OF CLOTHES/BATHING SUIT, AND WATER SHOES ON WATER DAY. NO CELL PHONES ALLOWED AT CAMP. SPECIAL DAYS MAY REQUIRE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR ICE CREAM, DONUTS OR TREATS.
- IT IS SUMMER SO THE MAJORITY OF THE DAY WILL BE SPENT OUTSIDE. PARTICIPANTS WILL ONLY BE INSIDE IF IT IS DEEMED TO BE UNSAFE (THUNDERSTORMS).

HIKES BIKES: GRADES 6, 7, 8

Hikes Bikes is an active group that will be on the go. They will need to be capable of biking long distances, carry a backpack throughout the day. The schedule of activities will include, but are not limited to, biking, hiking, swimming at water holes, field games, fishing, and day long adventures.

The mission of the Sticks for Kids program is to provide as many children as possible with a set of clubs to use while learning to play the game of golf. These clubs should be available for constant use while participants in the program are deciding whether to purchase their own set of clubs. The Sticks for Kids program will provide the opportunity for youth to experience a sport that teaches etiquette, discipline, integrity, and honor, as well as a competitive course to play at.

The six week camp will be held at the Colebrook Country Club for beginners to general golfers. Each session will include golf instruction from local golf volunteers. Participants that do not have a set of clubs will have a seasonal rental that they will be responsible for bringing to each of the weekly sessions. The golfer will be responsible for returning the set at the end of the golf season.

The first meeting is a Mandatory Orientation that will be held on Wednesday May 29th at 5:00pm for all participants and parents.


